Health Promoting Grant

The school has been awarded a new Health Promoting grant of £276. We have ordered a Buddy Bench for the playground which will be funded with this grant and some school funds remaining from a previous grant.

PE Lessons

A reminder that pupils have PE lessons on a Monday afternoon and Thursday morning. Pupils should ensure they have a full PE kit in school on those days – shorts, t-shirt, indoor\sports shoes (eg trainers) and a pair of jogging-type trousers\leggings – as lessons may at times be outside. Long hair will require to be tied back and any jewellery removed for PE lessons.

Daily Physical Exercise

The P7 pupils are currently receiving training so that they may lead DPA lessons for the other pupils each week.

Brass and Strings Lessons

Brass lessons will continue on a Wednesday with Ms De Villiers.

Gardening Days

We have included a few gardening days throughout the year when children should come to school in their own clothes and each class will spend some time during the day out in the school grounds generally tidying up – this has worked well in other schools and the children are keen to help keep our school tidy. Parent helpers would be very welcome to join a class on the gardening days. Gardening days will be in the new school calendar which will be sent home shortly.
